We are looking for:

- Someone who is first of all a Christian believer, committed to their own personal walk with Jesus.
- Someone who is keen to serve the Lord's people in a variety of different ways.
- Someone who is keen to grow both in spiritual maturity and practical ability.

The role involves:

- Helping with day-to-day administrative/office tasks, working alongside our Office Manager. Roughly the equivalent of 1.5-2 days a week.
- Serving with our youth and children's ministry team, both on Sunday mornings and midweek. This would, with appropriate training and oversight, include preparing and teaching sessions, and helping with the overall leadership of this ministry.
- Other opportunities to serve, e.g., our student ministry, personal work, evangelism.
- Being a regular part of the staff team and committed member of the church family.
- Options for theological education (e.g., the Union School of Theology G.Dip).
- Salary is aligned with National Living Wage and remuneration package includes various expenses incurred in the role.
